**General Recruitment to the posts of Post Graduate Teacher (BIOLOGICAL SCIENCE)
in TSWREI/MJPTBCWREI/TMREI/TTWREI/TREI Societies
Notification No.02/2018, Dated:30.06.2018.**

Amendment to Selection Notification

On the basis of the Written Examinations held on 03.10.2018 and 06.10.2018 and subsequent Certificate Verification process held on 18.01.2019, 19.01.2019 and 21.01.2019 at Telangana Social Welfare Residential School/College (Girls) Narsingi, Ranga Reddy District for Direct Recruitment (General) to the post of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) BIOLOGICAL SCIENCE subject in TSWREI/MJPTBCWREI/TMREI/TTWREI and TREI Societies, three hundred and thirty-three (333) candidates have been notified vide a selection notification, dated:13.03.2019, and details of the Hall Tickets etc., have been made available in TREIRB website. In the said list, among others, the Hall Ticket Numbers-428522 and 515394 have been included provisionally, since, the former studied her PG in Nutrition Dietetics and the latter studied his PG (i.e., one-year Diploma) in University of Teesside in UK. TREIRB vide its Letter No.53/TREIRB/2018, dated:08.04.2019 has informed the Telangana State Council of Higher Education that one candidate (H.T.No.428522) had studied her B.Sc. in Zoology, Chemistry and Applied Nutrition etc., M.Sc. in Nutrition Dietetics and she had studied B.Ed. with Biological Science as methodology and requested to clarify whether the M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics can be considered as a Life science subject in PG. In another case the TREIRB vide its Letter No.53/TREIRB/2018, dated:08.04.2019 has informed that Telangana State Council of Higher Education that one candidate (H.T.No.515394) had studied his M.Sc. in Bio-technology (i.e., one-year Diploma) from University of Teesside at UK and requested to inform whether the said M.Sc. course and the University of Teesside can be considered on par with the M.Sc. Life Science / Biotechnology courses of Indian Post Graduation courses recognized by UGC.

The Telangana State Council of Higher Education vide its letter No.TSCHE/Acad Cell/Equip/TREIRB/Clarif/Minutes/REIS-PG-BS/2019, dated:09.05.2019 has informed that it has constituted a Subject Expert Committee in the matter and the Committee met on 03.05.2019 and recommended that the M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics course (its syllabus) is not equivalent to M.Sc. Life Science/Botany/Zoology/...any other course given as eligibility for the post of Post-Graduation Teacher (PGT) in Biological Science at Residential Educational Institutions Societies (REIS) in TREIRB Notification No.2/2018, dated:30.06.2018. It has furnished minutes of the meeting of the Committee, in original.


In respect of the second case the Telangana State Council of Higher Education vide its letter No.TSCHE/Acad Cell/Equip/TREIRB/Clarif/Minutes/REIS-PG-BS/2019, dated:09.05.2019 has informed that it has constituted a Subject Expert Committee and the Committee met on 06.05.2019 and recommended that one year Diploma/M.Sc. Biotechnology course from the University of Teesside, UK cannot be considered on par with the two year M.Sc. Life Science/Bio-Technology course of Indian Post Graduation Courses which are recognized by the UGC for the post of Post-Graduation Teacher (PGT), Biological Science in Residential Educational Institutions Societies (REIS) as per the said notification. It has furnished the minutes of the meeting of the Committee, in original. The Telangana State Council of Higher Education in its further letter No.TSCHE/Equivalency/TREIRB/Teesside Uni/UK/AIU/2019, dt:17.06.2019 has informed that it has referred the matter to Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi for a clarification on the recognition of one year PG Diploma/M.Sc. Biotechnology course obtained from the University of Teesside, UK on par with two years M.S.c Life Science/Bio-Technology courses of Indian Post Graduation Courses which are recognized by the UGC, and that the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi has sent detailed information vide their letter, dated:22.05.2019 and furnished a copy of the same. The Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, while giving detailed reasons, has stated that in the light of the policy adopted by AIU, equivalence is not accorded to the degrees which are lesser in duration including Master degree and that equivalence has also not accorded to Postgraduate Diploma awarded by the British Universities.

In view of the above clarifications given by the Telangana State Council of Higher Education, TREIRB hereby delete the following Hall ticker numbers etc., from the selection notification notified on 13.03.2019.
